Section IX: Special Precautions

Precautions in handling and storage: Warning! Can cause skin and eye damage! Harmful if absorbed through skin or lungs. Keep container closed when not using. Do not store in unlabeled containers. Protect from freezing. Keep away from heat and open flame. Wear protective equipment when handling. Do not get in eyes or on skin or clothing. Avoid breathing mist. Use with adequate ventilation to maintain vapor concentrations below TLV levels. In case of contact, flush area with large amounts of water for 30 minutes and get medical attention. Wash contaminated clothing before reuse. Destroy contaminated leather shoes. Empty containers can be hazardous. Call for pickup and recycling by trained personnel.

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
